The tiltup feature of a comboard (combination inboardoutboard) means you can bring your Larson right up to the beach without worrying about prop damage. You can launch and recover from regular trailer ramps rather than the lift required for regular inboards. Also, there is more fuel economy with a 4 cycle engine. These benefits more than compensate for the extra cost.



You have better slow speed docking maneuverability than with an inboard, since the power thrust acts as a nidder.



Sound is damped and muffled by Larson's insuilated engine enclosure and the new "sound benier" boards. Expended vinyl pedding and twin rear sexts are standard.


